The Canton of Fribourg proposes a multitude of benefits to Fribourg companies, whether they be start-ups, SMEs or large companies with over 150 employees (FTE). Some support measures have been designed to benefit all companies (linkage and referral service, the platinn network for coaching and strategic consulting, Cautionnement Romand (loan guarantee association), technology platforms, clusters and competence centers), while others are exclusively targeted at a certain category of companies (coordination, participation in covering rental costs, HR measures, process optimization, new markets, seed capital, venture capital, interest subsidies, tax incentives).

Only companies that meet the criteria of non-distortion of competition, along with that of innovation, value creation, and regional economic impact are eligible to benefit from the latter category of support measures. These criteria are defined in the Law on Economic Promotion (LPEc).

The granting of financial support and its overall value is assessed based on a business plan. Financial support of companies can be in the form of non-repayable grants or capital- or loan-financing measures.
